The Traffic Committee asked me the following question number 612, in a letter on 9 May 2008, which I answered preliminary on 2 June 2008, and to which I shall disclose additional information:

Question number 612:

“In continuation of the answering of TRU question number 226, the Minister is asked to transmit information concerning which flights International Group LLC and Universal Weather & Aviation have paid fees for in Denmark.”

Answer:

In my preliminary response on 2 June 2008, I informed that EUROCONTROL had been approached, in relation to obtaining the wanted information.

The data is contained in two lists, as annexed to the e-mail on 2 June 2008 and the letter from EUROCONTROL on 12 June 2008. Copies are enclosed here.

The lists concern the paying of fees by Universal Weather Aviation. The first list concerns flight between 1 April 2003 to 31 March 2008 and the second list concerns flights between 1 December 2001 to 27 May 2008. The two lists are set up in different ways, but for the time between 1 May 2003 to 31 March 2008 they both concern the same flights.

According to the data from EUROCONTROL, International Group LLC has not paid for flights. According to the information available to EUROCONTROL, this company carries out flights with one aircraft (N63MU) and payment of charges for flights of this aircraft is contained in the specified tables, as Universal Weather & Aviation performs flight planning services in relation to this aircraft.

In the response of TRU question number 226, on the basis of the statement obtained from EUROCONTROL, it has been disclosed that International Group LLC also paid fees.

The Civil Aviation Administration has therefore obtained an additional statement concerning this question from EUROCONTROL, which informs that, in the search through EUROCONTROL's database, identities of companies have been confused, as International Group LLC was considered to be the same as International Lease Finance Corporation (ILFC). EUROCONTROL has apologized for the error.
